Reader: For all affected by war, terrorism or natural disaster; for those who have died, for the bereaved, for those who are injured and for those left homeless.

Reader: For our own parish community, that each of us may learn to place all our hope and faith in the promises of the Lord and so be witnesses to the power of God's grace.

Reader: Let us remember especially today those for whom our masses are offered this weekend. Also, all the faithful departed, especially any dear loved ones who have died in the past year, and those of our who have died recently. May they be raised up on the last day.

Reader: Let us pray for our own private intentions; (pause). We ask Mary, our Mother, to join her prayers to ours: **Hail Mary ...**
