1ST SUNDAY OF LENT

Reader: Let us remember those intentions for which our Masses are offered this weekend; also, all the faithful departed, especially Jack Lawson, Peter Dawson, Ena Bolton, Mary Bilsborough, Fr. Bob Morrow, and Agnes Walker who have died recently, may they be raised up on the last day. Lord in your mercyHear our prayer
